

SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANT AVAILABLE

Secondary School (Post Primary) Scholarship

Opening: 1 September Closing: 31 October

- 1. The Papawai & Kaikōkirikiri Trusts Secondary School (Post Primary) Scholarship is provided to support students with the purchase of school books, clothing, sports events, field trips, other equipment or payment of school fees. This scholarship is for years 9 13 and includes day, full-time and part-time boarding students. The closing date for this scholarship is 31 October the year prior to attending the secondary school.
- 2. The scholarship is paid to the school once attendance is confirmed.

Leadership and Personal Development Scholarship

Opening: 1 February Closing: 31 March

- The Papawai & Kaikōkirikiri Trusts Leadership and Personal Development Scholarship is provided to support students to attend programmes for leadership and personal development. This scholarship is for years 11 - 13 and includes day, full-time and part-time boarding students.
- 2. This scholarship is paid to the programme provider or school once acceptance into the programme is confirmed, and must be used in the year to which it is granted.

Discretionary Grant

Open all school year

- 1. This grant is available annually for years 9 13 to provide students, who demonstrate a financial need to meet school costs such as assistance to purchase a uniform or school books, school clothing and aids to support learning.
- 2. Evidence of support from the school Principal/Dean/Counsellor must be provided.
- 3. This grant is paid on provision of a receipt, or directly to the supplier of the goods on invoice to the Trust, or to the school.

CRITERIA FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS

- Provide evidence of whakapapa to Tangata Whenua of Wairarapa.
- Be enrolled at a Secondary School in NZ.
- Be under 20 years of age at 1st February.
- · Meet all the criteria for the scholarship or grant applied for; and
- · Submit the completed application and supporting documentation on time.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. Incomplete or late applications may not be considered.
- 2. A completed Wairarapa Whakapapa Form must be submitted with every application unless there has been a previous scholarship or grant approved for the student concerned.
- A Parent/Guardian/Caregiver may complete the application form but the personal details are those of the student and the address must be the student's home address even if they are at boarding school.
- 4. Applications can be submitted online, emailed, via post, couried or delivered to the office in person.
- 5. Application and additional information must reach the Papawai & Kaikōkirikiri Trusts office by the closing date.
- 6. The Trust must be advised of any changes to the application in writing (i.e. change of school or address).
- 7. Successful applicants will be notified in writing.
- 8. If the application deadline falls on a weekend or public holiday, the deadline is extended to 2pm on the next business day.
